

Oregon School District ESSER Fund Expenditures

The Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief Fund (ESSER Fund) was established in March 2020 to provide emergency relief funds to address the impact that COVID-19 has had on elementary and secondary schools across the Nation. Additional information about ESSER funds can be found [here](#).
