



What is Plagiarism? Flash Cards Study Aid

Take some time to carefully read the “What is Plagiarism” packet. As you read, highlight or underline key concepts and facts. In the margin, write questions you have about key concepts or facts.

Then, make a set of plagiarism flash cards to help you study and remember the key concepts you highlighted. On the front, write a key word or phrase; on the back, write a description, definition, or statement. Make at least 20 flash cards, and be sure to include the concepts you find most challenging or difficult to remember.

Use your flash cards to help you study for the plagiarism test. Your flash cards will be collected with your test, and I will be checking your “What is Plagiarism” packet for highlighting and questions.
