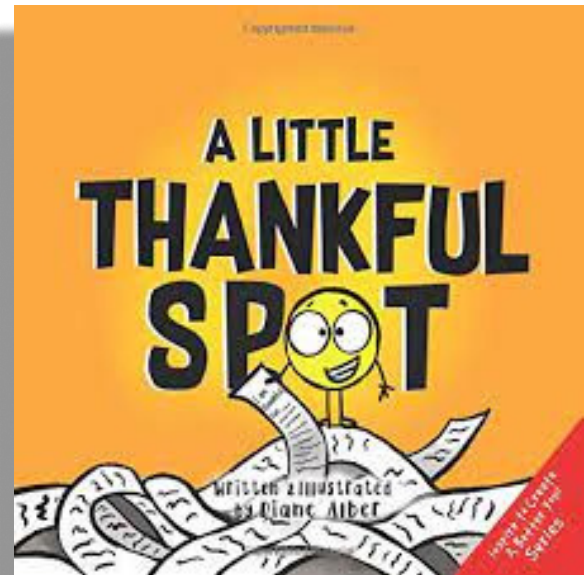

Please pull up in front of door four and open your trunk or roll down your window and a staff member will retrieve the bag of materials.



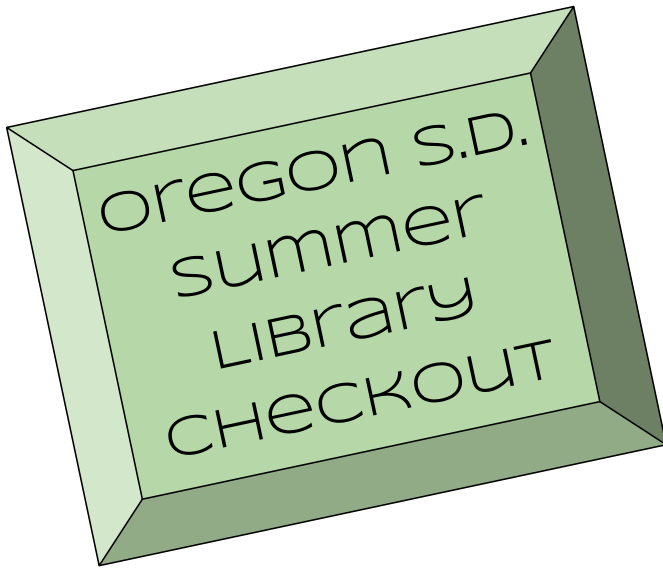
Garden
